The Lake County Division of Transportation (LCDOT) is proposing improvements to the intersection of Wilson Road and Nippersink Road in the Village of Round Lake and unincorporated Grant Township in Lake County, Illinois. The existing intersection is all-way stop controlled. The improvements call for a new traffic signal at the intersection and reconstruction and widening of the existing two-lane cross section with shoulders to a three-lane cross section with curb and gutter and a dedicated left turn lane for all four approaches. Other improvements include a storm sewer system, shared-use path, erosion control, pavement marking and signing, and other related roadway items.
