

## Frequently Asked Questions about Hepatitis C Testing and Treatment

Where can I get tested? Hepatitis C testing is available at the Health Department's Belvidere Medical Building in Waukegan located at 2400 Belvidere Road. The entrance to the clinic is on Dodge Avenue, just off of Keller Avenue. Hepatitis C Testing is offered on a limited basis through an appointment only. To make an appointment or get additional information, call 847.377.8450.

What can I expect? Hepatitis C screening is offered to anyone **concerned about exposure to Hepatitis C** ~~born between 1945 and 1965 or to anyone who has a high risk for acquiring Hepatitis C~~, such as blood exposure to someone who is infected the Hepatitis C virus. When getting a Hepatitis C screening you should expect to be here for 30 minutes. You will meet with a counselor who will answer any questions you might have. This screening test is done through a blood sample. The test is a rapid test and results are available within 20 minutes. There is no cost for the screening.

What if I have Hepatitis C and want to be treated for it? Hepatitis C treatment is available at several of the Health Departments's helath center locations. To make an appointment or get additional information, call 847.377.8450.
