A global, developmental screening takes a quick look at all areas of a child's development: motor, language, cognitive, social-emotional and adaptive skills. The results of the screening compare the child to other children of the same age in each area of development. If a concern shows up on the screening, the evaluator may recommend that the child go through a more in-depth assessment, called an evaluation, to see if a true developmental delay may exist.
