The clerk posts notices and cancellations of county meetings, legal notices for state and federal agency informational deadlines and current year budgets for all county taxing jurisdictions.

Assumed Business Name Filings

Individuals, sole proprietorships, and general partnerships doing business in Lake County under an assumed name are required to register the business name with the county clerk's office.

Tax Extension & Redemption

The county clerk has two tax responsibilities - Tax Extension and Redemption. Tax Extension is the property tax rate calculation based on local taxing districts' levy ordinances and assessor's property values. Tax Redemption is the county clerk's processing of delinquent property tax payments after the tax lien sale and before property foreclosures.
