The Lake County Sheriff's Office is the largest law enforcement agency in Lake County. Below is a brief summary of the many services provided by the Office. The Office Operations Division maintains a Criminal Investigations Unit divided into the following:

- ✓ Cyber Crimes Section
- ✓ Evidence Technicians
- ✓ Juvenile Investigations Section
- ✓ Lake County MEG
- ✓ Major Crimes Task Force
- ✓ Photography Team
- ✓ Sex Offender Team
- ✓ Special Investigations Section



The Operations Division also maintains a Highway Patrol Unit providing law enforcement service to all residents of unincorporated Lake County and six (6) contractual municipalities. Highway Patrol also manages the following:

- ✓ 911 Communications Center
- ✓ K-9 Team
- ✓ Reserve Deputy Unit
- ✓ Special Response Team
- ✓ Tactical Response Team
- ✓ Technical Crash Investigation
- ✓ Traffic Enforcement

The Marine Unit takes to the waterways from mid-May through mid-October responding to calls for assistance, investigating criminal complaints and boating accidents, providing watercraft safety inspections, search and rescue service, as well as crowd control and security.

The Lake County Sheriff's Office operates a correctional facility, serves as the administrative arm of the court fulfilling the Sheriff's statutory responsibilities to serve all civil papers including Court Orders, Writs, Summons, Subpoenas, Civil Warrants, as well as Orders of Judgment, Court-Ordered Evictions and Tax Deed Notices. The Sheriff's Office also maintains the constitutional and statutory requirement to enforce criminal warrants directed to them by the Lake County Circuit Court.
