

Tim Cook, CFM, CPESC, CWS – *Water Resources Professional*: Responsibilities include: site development, including SMC permitted development inspections for soil erosion and sediment control compliance, and overall permit conditions; community assistance; and development reviews as necessary. Serves as a team leader during flood response.

Scott Griffith- P.E., CFM – *Regulatory Engineer Supervisor*: Manages the permitting staff; oversees the Watershed Development Ordinance community certification process; develops hydraulic and hydrologic models; and facilitates WDO permitting issue resolution.



JULI CRANE

Juli E. Crane, PWS, CWS, LEED BD+C – *Principal Wetland Specialist*: Juli performs field wetland jurisdictional determinations and wetland delineations, reviews permit applications for potential wetland impacts, conducts wetland-related site inspections, and provides technical assistance of wetland restoration projects. She also provides technical support for wetland-related planning efforts and flood response.

Ernesto Huaracha – *Water Resources Professional*: Responsibilities include: watershed assessment and planning; stormwater and watershed management program development; surface water monitoring; stream restoration project planning, design, and construction; stormwater management practice planning, design, and construction; grant procurement, management, and administration; and public education and outreach.

Bob Gardiner – PE, CFM – *Permit Review Engineer*: Reviews permit applications for base flood elevation determinations, public road developments, Lake County Forest Preserve projects, and other governmental, residential, and commercial developments. Also manages the rain gage program and periodically sends out storm summary reports to a variety of users.

Jeff Laramy – GISP – *Sr. GIS Analyst*: Provides GIS/GPS data analysis and mapping support for staff; maintains computer network, including software and equipment upgrades, and new technology; and provides IT support to staff. He also manages the SMC internship program, including interviewing, hiring, and intern oversight.

Darcy McNeill – *Executive Assistant*: Provides administrative support to staff; manages the contact database; and manages the CPF 2nd floor conference room reservation process.
