## **One of the Most Wanted Fugitives in Wisconsin Apprehended**

On June 25, 2018, members of the Lake County Sheriff's Office Warrants Team and U.S. Marshals Service-Great Lakes Regional Fugitive Task Force (USMS-GLRFTF) apprehended Terrance F. Williams, 59, of the 1900 block of Lewis Avenue, Waukegan.

Williams was wanted on a no bond failure to appear arrest warrant for 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Sexual Assault Person Under 12, 1<sup>st</sup> Degree Child Sex Assault Person Under 13, Repeated Sexual Assault of Same Child, 3<sup>rd</sup> Degree Sexual Assault Exposing to Child, 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Sexual Assault (warrant from Milwaukee, Wisconsin investigation).

Members of the Lake County Sheriff's Office Warrants Team and US Marshals Team developed information that Williams left Wisconsin and obtained a new identity under a false name. Williams was located and arrested by the two agencies, with the assistance of Deputy Arrowood and his K-9 partner Duke, at the above address.
