Your First Appointment

At your first appointment, a dentist will:

- Review your medical and dental history and evaluate your oral health
- Take necessary dental X-rays
- Discuss your oral health concerns and needs

Insurance Accepted

We welcome all patients. We accept insurance, including Medicaid, Medicare, and Children's Health Insurance Program (CHIP).

We offer discounted fees for patients who qualify. We do not deny services based on a person's inability to pay.

Insurance Limits

Your insurance may cover some procedures only once or twice a year. We may recommend procedures sooner than your insurance will cover. You will be responsible for payment of any procedure your insurance does not cover.

Some treatments may need to be approved by your insurance company first.

Fees / Deductibles

All payments, including discounted fees, are collected at the time of service. We accept cash, credit or debit cards, and checks.
