Type a detailed description of the project:

The project consist of milling the existing pavement, resurfacing St Mary's Rd & Everett Rd to a hard profile; minimal widening to a standard 11' lane with 4' paved & 3' aggregate shoulders; correcting the pavement cross slope to a 2% standard; regrading existing ditch lines to provide safer fore slopes and positive drainage; and other related work. The project also includes constructing a section of bike path on the south side of Everett Rd to connect existing LCFPD bike path sections; removing and replacing existing guardrail; constructing curb and gutter; and replacing existing drainage structures along the along the south side of Everett Rd east and west of the I-94 overpass.
