

Registration Form - Residential Residing

You may complete this registration form (in lieu of applying for a permit) when proposed improvements consist of **only** residing your residential structure. A permit shall be required if residing is part of: 1) a larger project that involves interior alterations or additions, 2) a commercial project, or 3) property has red tag. This process is designed to maximize customer convenience. However, the customer always has the right to seek a permit and a follow-up inspection. Lake County reserves the right to inspect any improvement performed whether permitted or registered.

Registrations can also be applied for in person at the Central Permit Facility. A non-refundable registration fee (per structure) is required and can be made with cash, check or credit card. The fee schedule can be found at lakecountyil.gov/3678/fee-schedule.

UPON SUBMISSION AND REVIEW OF THIS FORM, YOUR PROJECT WILL BE REGISTERED. CONSTRUCTION CANNOT BEGIN UNTIL YOU RECEIVE CONFIRMATION FROM THIS OFFICE THAT YOUR REGISTRATION IS COMPLETE. NOTE: By signing below you agree to comply with the requirements of the Solid Waste Hauling and Recycling Ordinance by diverting 75% of construction and demolition debris generated by this project.
