



## Senior Citizens Assessment Freeze Homestead Exemption Online Instructions

Our office has an e-filing portal where you can set up a personal account, apply on-line and then receive notification on the status of the application. Go to [assessor.lakecountyil.gov](http://assessor.lakecountyil.gov) then click on the Smartfile E-Filing Portal. Complete your application online.

### Homestead Exemption Assistance

You may visit your local Township Assessor at any time, or utilize an Outreach Session. The Chief County Assessment Office and the Lake County Township Assessors Association will hold several public outreach sessions to assist residents in completing the 2019 Senior Citizen Assessment Freeze Application for taxes payable in 2020; as well as service taxpayer needs on other homestead exemptions offered. Residents will work one on one with a staff member to complete the necessary exemption forms.

Be prepared to bring copies of income received such as:

- 2018 Federal Income Tax Form
- Social Security Statement (SSA-1099)

If the property is owned in Trust, you may need to provide proof of the beneficiary.
