This course will be instructed by Spanish-speaking members of the Lake County Sheriff's Office. It is a free course and applicants will get an in-depth view of all Sheriff's Office responsibilities, including Corrections, Highway Patrol, Court Security, Criminal Investigations, Crash Investigations, Evidence Processing, and more.
