Prairie State Legal Services offers free legal services to low income people who have legal barriers to getting or keeping a job.

How can PSLS help?

PSLS may be able to **advise you about legal issues stopping you from getting or keeping work** including:

- Criminal records
- Credit report concerns
- Getting a driver's license
- Getting other professional licenses
- Child care issues
- Consumer issues relating to a vehicle needed for work

PSLS may be able to **represent you in court or other proceedings** including:

- Sealing your criminal record
- Expunging your criminal record
- Reinstating your driver's license
- Appealing denials of professional licenses or DCFS indications
- Modifying parenting schedules to accommodate work
