# New for 2019: Appeals Must Be Filed Electronically

As a property owner, you can appeal your assessment through the Lake County Board of Review. **No attorney** is required for a residential appeal.

Prior to filing a formal appeal to the Board of Review, property owners in Waukegan Township are encouraged to contact the township assessor's office at 847-623-4550 to discuss their concerns.

# Apply for Homestead Exemptions Online
