Lake County Parking Garage Closure Notice

The Lake County parking garage has been closed to undergo a rehabilitation project. The work will consist of repairing exposed steel and structural cracks, replacing failing drains and storm water plumbing lines, installing two additional electric vehicle charging stations, and resurfacing the lower level. Please note that the anticipated date to reopen the parking garage has been pushed back to the week of December 7th.



During the closure, all visitors will need to park in the on street metered spaces or at the City of Waukegan parking garage located at 225 N County St.
