

# CREATE AN ACCOUNT AND REGISTER

## Step 1: Go to [AllVax.lakecohealth.org](https://AllVax.lakecohealth.org).

## Step 2: Enter your information.

- Enter your first name, last name, and email address.
- Select your language of choice.
- Check the box to Accept Terms of Registration.
- Click "Next".

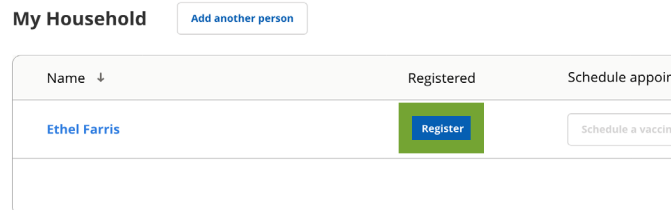
After you click "Next", click "Finish".

## Step 3: Check your email.

- Check your email inbox for an email from the Lake County Health Department. If you don't see one, check your junk folder.
- Click the link in the email showing that your login id is your email.
- A new page will open. Create a password.
- Click "Change Password"

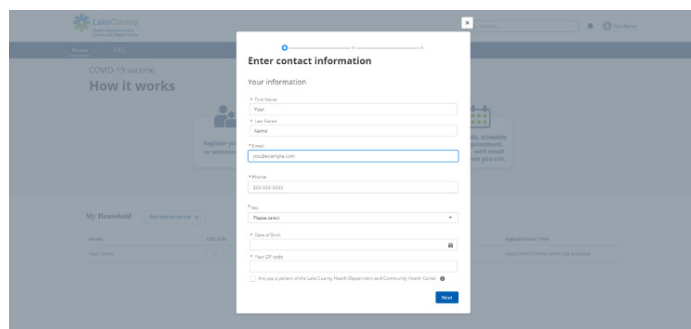
## Step 4: Begin registration

You have now created an account and will be returned to the home page of the community portal. You can register yourself by clicking on the “Register” button next to your name. You can also register another person by clicking on the “Add another person” button. Once you register, we will notify you when it is time to make an appointment for a COVID-19 vaccine.



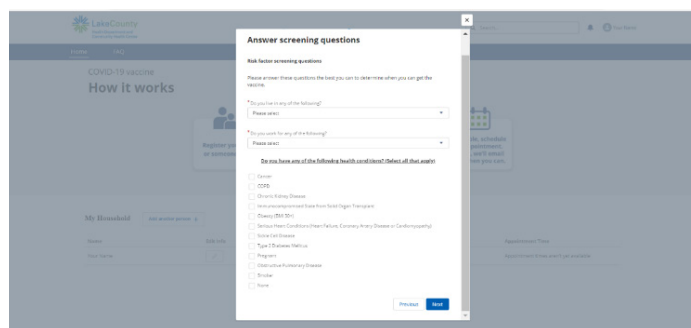
## Step 5: Enter your information.

Enter your contact information. Click “Next”.



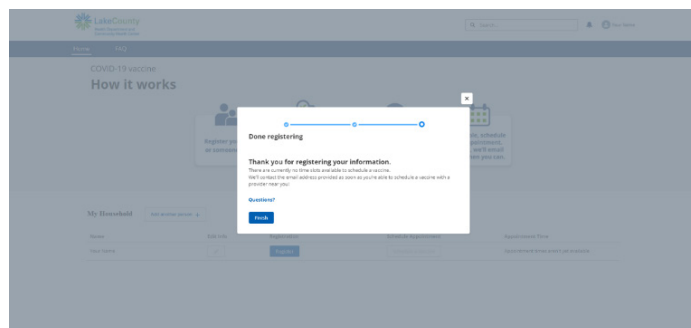
## Step 6: Answer the screening questions.
