## Mass Vaccination Volunteer Information

**Thank you for your interest to volunteer with the Lake County Health Department as part of our mass vaccination effort.**

- We ask that our volunteers commit to at least 8 shifts (9 a.m. to 4 p.m.) within a 10-week period.
- Opportunities for non-medical volunteers include traffic control, check-in/data entry screeners, and our customer support team (remote role).
- Opportunities for individuals with a valid medical license include vaccinators, vaccination mixers, and wellness check observers.

**Please review the checklist below to prepare for completing the virtual application** to not delay your engagement, sign where needed, provide copies of any requested credentials, along with proof of requested training completion and return for processing.

**To ensure you are able to volunteer as quickly as possible once you complete your application, your completed virtual must include:**

- Signed Confidentiality Agreement (form is provided within the application)
- Completion of OSHA Training or proof of prior completion
- Attestation to review of policies and procedures
- Emergency contact information

**For medical volunteers, the following additional requirements are needed:**

- Copy of your medical certificate or license
- Copy of your CPR certification (Wellness Check Observers Only)
- Certificates of Completion for the following training (Vaccinators & Vaccine Mixers Only)
  - COVID Vaccine training through CDC
  - Moderna training and
  - Pfizer training
