



Frequently Asked Questions – Brooks Farm Water Tower

When will this project start and how long will it last?

Construction is anticipated to begin in April/May of 2021 and will last for approximately 3 months.

What is that large curtain I see around the tower?

The curtain is in place to contain materials during paint removal and to prevent over spray during paint application. The ground surface will also be protected with tarps to contain materials that fall to the ground. The contractor will also implement a dust filtration system as a part of the curtain setup to contain all materials.

Does the existing tower paint contain lead?

No, the existing tower paint does not contain lead.

Will the new tower paint contain lead?

No, the new paint that will be applied will not contain lead.

What will the re-painted tower look like?

The tower will be repainted with the same color scheme as the existing tower.

Will the project impact area roadways?

The project is not anticipated to have major effects on vehicular traffic on area roadways, but the project may require intermittent bike path and roadway lane closures during construction. Any impacted areas of the roadway or bike path will be indicated as closed with proper barricades and signage.

Will I have water during the project and will my water be safe to drink during the project?

Yes, your water will be safe to drink during the project. During the project, Lake County will shut down well water sources and temporarily acquire water from the Village of Round Lake. Water being provided to customers will continue to be safe to use and drink throughout the project. Upon completion of the project, the water source will be shifted back to Lake County's wells.
