North Barrington was informed of this decision this week -- this is a terrible oversight on your part. I'm not sure how this happened but it's really inexcusable. This change will NOT alter the school district zoning, but will surely affect our property values -- Realistically speaking, that means my TAXES ARE GOING UP. A Few Facts 1. Lake county's population has seen a drop and is currently at 714,000. We currently have 21 districts, and the goal is to reduce that to 19 districts, i.e., ~ 37,500 per district. 2. North Barrington has a population of about 3100 so whichever district we are included in, as a Village we will really have about 10% of representation/leverage, if any, over election issues, including how funds are allocated. 3. Therefore, it makes sense that we are grouped with like-minded, like-demographics, like-needs communities. Since the incorporation of our Village in 1959 we have been grouped with the Barrington area and we should remain with our collective of like-minded villages so that our voices are served with a vote that matters. Based on the information from the Waconda and North Barrington websites it is very clear that there are striking differences in our beliefs and desires for our communities. • "Today, Wauconda has a thriving business community with a unique mix of retailers, service providers, and industry. The Village's elected officials and administrative staff take a proactive approach to economic development through teamwork and streamlined services." • "One of the highest priorities of the Village [of North Barrington] is to preserve the unique character of the village. Considering that nearly all of the actions and decisions of the various public and private forces both inside and outside of the village can have a potential influence on the future of the village and ultimately its residents, it is no challenge to be taken lightly. The potential impacts, both great and small, can have effects on economics, lifestyles, education, social participation within and outside of the community, intrinsic property values, and relations with neighboring municipalities, just to name a few of the potential effects. Dear Members of the Lake County Reapportionment Committee:

After careful review of the proposed reapportionment plan, a consortium of Elected Officials of Western Lake County has officially joined together to object to this proposal.

Our objections to this plan are based on the following reasons:

1. All the significant commercial and residential growth in Lake County is and will occur in the municipalities within the current boundaries of District 5. This area is still in great need of infrastructure investments in water, sewer, and roads improvements. These investments are vital to sustaining the current and future growth of this region and Lake County.

Our communities collaboratively have taken a regional approach in promoting the region for development and addressing infrastructure needs. These proposed changes will bifurcate the region, making these communities compete for infrastructure funding. This proposed plan has the potential to hinder future development and growth.

2. The populations of the current County Board District 5 grew by 10%. The new proposed boundaries did not have to change by 50%. One thousand voters could have easily adjusted this down by following the boundaries of Rt 12 and 120.

3. The current County Board District 1 lost population by 2.37% and did not have to cut Antioch Township in half. An adjustment to increase voters in District 1 should be done by coming down Grass Lake Road and picking up several Antioch Township precincts that were in current District 5.

4. The Proposed Reapportionment Plan place other municipalities into Districts that have no similarity to environmental or economic issues.

- a. The proposed plan cuts out a large portion of a predominant Latino area in the present District 5 boundaries in the Round Lake Area. This proposed plan divides those subdivisions into a different County Board District, grouping them into another Board District 17 with Barrington.
- b. To our knowledge, the Mexican American Legal Defense and Educational Fund (MALDEF) has not commented on the proposed plan, especially the proposed changes to District 5. This organization did file an objection in 2010 on boundary changes based on the allegation of disenfranchising Latino residents of Lake County. This action caused Lake County to redraw the boundaries based on this objection.
- 9. The proposed boundary maps for western Lake County are not compact.
- 10. The proposed maps undermine the electoral process by disenfranchising constituents by denying them the opportunity to vote for the County Board Member who has represented them for years.
- 11. The proposed plan maps for western Lake County appear to be gerrymandered, placing board members against one another while creating an open county board district.
- 12. The current District 19 board district appears to be gerrymandered, whereas the current Board Member would be running in a completely different district than elected.
- 13. Significant issues with the process.
 - a. The site for public comment had recording issues because of mobile integration problems not allowing residents a voice in the proposals.
 - b. The public comment on the site only allowed residents 255 characters to voice their concerns, and anything over that amount would be kicked back and not recorded.
 - c. The time was inadequate by only allowing five business days during a holiday period for public comment with a crashing site. This is not in the public's best interest for public engagement.
 - d. The presentation and engagement of this proposed plan with Lake County Municipal and Township Leaders was poor and, in many instances, was non-existent. Accessing the information of this plan in a timely matter was a significant challenge hindering the time needed to review and formulate an opinion.

As representatives of the constituents of Western Lake County, please take our comments and concerns into consideration. We request the committee review our concerns, engage with us, and amend the proposed district maps for Western Lake County.
