Lake County has a new procurement system called Job Order Contracting (JOC). JOC is a firm, fixed priced, competitively bid, indefinite quantity procurement tool designed to complete small to medium-sized repair and rehabilitation projects. As JOC is fast-track, Lake County is using it to complete its inventory of unexecuted purchase orders quickly.



Job Order Contracting (JOC):

- **Simplifies the procurement process for Lake County allowing them to procure more work in a shorter period of time**
- **Has benefits for both Lake County as well as the subcontracting community**
- **Is a performance based contracting system that determines the amount of work to be issued**
- **Can increase participation by the local contracting community in that it puts more work on the on the street for bidding**
