Sheriff Idleburg Again Partners with Illinois Sheriffs' Association to Award Student Scholarship

Sheriff John D. Idleburg is proud to partner with the Illinois Sheriffs' Association to award a \$1,000 school scholarship to a Lake County resident, for an institution of higher learning. The scholarship is to be applied to tuition, books and fees only. The student must be enrolled full-time at a certified institution of higher learning within the State of Illinois, full-time online learning is acceptable.

There will be no restriction on any applicant by reason of race, age, creed, color, sex, sexual orientation, national origin, or other protected classes. The only limitations are as follows:

- Applicants must be permanent Illinois residents and reside in the county in which they are applying
- Scholarships must be utilized at institutions of higher learning within the State of Illinois
- Students must be enrolled as a full-time student during the 2022-2023 school year (**excluding summer session**)

Sheriff John D. Idleburg said, "I enjoy every opportunity to give back to the community. I look forward to being able to award a Lake County student \$1,000.00, which can be used to offset some of the expenses of schooling."
