
Construction Resumes – Lake County Public Works Water Main Interconnect Project

Dear Business Owner:

During the week of April 25, 2022, construction will resume in front of Apple Orchard Square for the interconnection between Lake County's Vernon Hills water system and the Village of Lincolnshire's water system. The new interconnection is an upgrade that allows water to be transferred between systems in an emergency if either system loses water. The interconnection creates a more resilient water system and aligns with Lake County Public Works' (LCPW) mission to provide efficient, safe and reliable water services to our customers.

Timeline for Construction

- Construction is expected to begin in **late April** and will occur over a one-month period, weather dependent.
- Anticipated on **Monday, April 25th**, two parking spaces at the southwest end of the parking lot will need to be occupied by construction equipment during daytime hours. Excavation work will take place in the grass area.
- On **Tuesday, April 26th**, a crane is scheduled to access the parking lot very early in the morning (ahead of business hours) to facilitate the installation of a large concrete structure in the grass area.
- After **April 26th**, construction operations in the grass area will be ongoing throughout daytime hours, but business and parking impacts from construction should be minimal.



Water service to the strip mall is not expected to be impacted. Driveway access to Apple Orchard Square and parking at the strip mall will be maintained throughout the project. Any disturbed grass areas will be restored once construction is complete.

The majority of the construction work will be completed by the LCPW Maintenance Division crews. This work is being completed in support of one of our capital improvement projects.
