Homestead Exemptions for Your Primary Residence

There are several exemptions available to provide tax relief to homeowners. These include an exemption for owner-occupied residences and additional ones for senior citizens, disabled persons, disabled veterans and veterans that have returned from armed conflict within the last two years. You can file for these exemptions in the comfort of your own home through the Smartfile E-Filing portal!

Discover the Waukegan Savanna Dog Park

The Forest Preserves operate five off-leash dog exercise areas, including Waukegan Savanna Dog Park. This is the newest park and the only one that features a separate enclosed area for small dogs weighing less than 25 pounds. Annual or daily permits are required.



Forest Preserve Trivia

Van Patten Woods was Lake County's first forest preserve, created in 1961 with a 162-acre purchase. In the 1970s the abandoned gravel pit that is now Sterling Lake was acquired. Major restoration that took place between 1989 and 1993 resulted in the safe and clean preserve we enjoy today.
