

MONKEYPOX (MPV) TREATMENT FLOWCHART

Tecovirimat (TPOXX) patient referral to LCHD

1

Non-LCHD Primary Care Provider (PCP) identifies a positive MPV patient who would benefit from TPOXX treatment.

2

Non-LCHD PCP calls the LCHD Communicable Disease (CD) team at (847) 377-8130 to consult the need for TPOXX for MPV treatment.

3

If TPOXX treatment is approved the LCHD CD team will refer to LCHD Sexually Transmitted Infection (STI) Program to schedule an appointment for the patient.

Receive TPOXX for your patients

1

Patient presents with MPV-like symptoms.

2

Provider submits for MPV testing. If test positive, check if patient has indications for TPOXX treatment

3

If patient has indications for treatment, complete the TPOXX Administration Form.

4

Provider electronically signs and submits Provider Agreement (1x) and submits TPOXX Administration Form for **each** patient.

5

Smartsheet will notify LCHD.

6

LCHD will review case and indications for treatment.

7

LCHD will coordinate pick-up or delivery of TPOXX.

8

Provider coordinates with patient for pick-up and submits Investigational New Drug (IND) forms to CDC and dph.tpoxx@illinois.gov within 7 days.

9

Follow up visit with provider and completion of any additional documents for treatment.
