KEY RESPONSIBILITY AREAS

- Setup, calibrate, monitor, run and troubleshoot to ensure efficient performance of Level 1 machinery: Sauce Depositor, Case Taper, Waterfalls and Pepomatics.
- Communicate with Material Handler Production employees to ensure proper product is consistently available for the area of influence to ensure maximized run times are achieved.
- Utilizes partnerships with support department (maintenance, QA, sanitation, warehouse) to ensure efficient problem solving for day-to-day issues.
- Ensure that the operation complies with GMP's, safety, quality, SOP'S, and that the equipment is in good mechanical condition by visual inspection, identifying any problems and reporting to the Lead or Supervisor if repairs are needed.
- May be required to shut the equipment down and prepare for cleaning.
- Participate in functional training of co-workers as necessary to maintain efficiency and coverage during operation.
- Complete all required reports, documentation, etc. and input any information into the production system. Perform all SPC checks, record and modify equipment to ensure correct product.
- Make setting adjustments on equipment as necessary during the production run.
- Ensure that the operation complies with GMP's, safety, quality, and SOPs.
- Ensure that the equipment to be operated is in good mechanical condition by visual inspection, identify any problems and contact maintenance for repair.
- Participate in Preventive Maintenance on Sundays.
- Must be able to work with a flexible schedule including overtime and weekend shift coverage.

Sanitation Technician II – 3rd Shift – 10:00 pm – 6:30 am

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KEY RESPONSIBILITY AREAS

- Breaking down, reassembling, cleaning, and sanitizing manufacturing equipment nightly.
- Foaming and hand-scrubbing floors and walls.
- Cleaning of production and non-production areas in mostly indoor environment.
- Participating in pre-operation inspections of the equipment after the clean.
- Maintaining a Safe and Food Safe environment through teamwork and proper food sanitation training.
- Overall sanitation of a USDA food plant.
- Utilizes all Sanitation Standard Operating Procedures (SSOP's).
- Must be able to balance on ladders and on top of platforms and equipment.
- Ability to use power tools to include pressure washer.
- Performs a variety of duties while standing, lifting, walking, or stooping/crouching.
- Adheres to and understands Good Manufacturing Practices (GMP), Personal Protective Equipment (PPE), Standard Operating Procedures (SOP's).
- Exposure to potentially wet, hot, humid, cold, and slippery conditions.
- Maintain commitment to personal development and participate in job specific training.
- Perform other duties as assigned.

SKILLS AND KNOWLEDGE

- Two years' experience in a food manufacturing plant (preferred but not required)
- Bi-lingual (English and Spanish) reading, writing, and speaking (preferred not required)
- Basic math skills of addition, subtraction, multiplication, and division

PHYSICAL REQUIREMENTS, WORK ENVIRONMENT (summary)

- Must be able to work in temperature-controlled environments associated with ovens, freezers and refrigerated warehouses.
- Will be exposed to cold temperatures in the plant. Frequent walking and exposure to outdoor weather is required. The employee is frequently required to talk, hear, and use hands or fingers to handle, feel or grasp.
- Must be able to stand and bend for long periods of time.
- The employee is occasionally required to sit; reach with hands and arms; lift up to 50 lbs., and kneel, crouch, or crawl.
- Specific vision abilities required by this job include overall vision, color vision, and depth perception.

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
