

ORDINANCE 2007-0-

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTIONS 15-B, 15-E, 15-F AND 3.5-C OF THE OLD MILL CREEK DEVELOPMENT CODE

WHEREAS, the Development Code of the Village of Old Mill Creek provides regulation of signs through permit and regulation of special uses, and

WHEREAS, the corporate authorities of the Village find it is the best interest of the Village to amend said Development Code as stated below, and

WHEREAS, the Plan Commission has held Public Hearings to consider the amendments and have passed resolutions recommending the adoption of said amendments.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE PRESIDENT AND BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF OLD MILL CREEK, ILLINOIS, AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1: Section 3.5-C. Special Uses, 1. Residential Uses of the Development Code of the Village of Old Mill Creek is hereby amended to add the following sentence:

Single Family Detached Dwellings

SECTION 2: Section 15-B. Sign Permits, First paragraph of the Development Code of the Village of Old Mill Creek is hereby amended to read as follows:

No commercial sign or any sign erected in connection with any election, referendum or political campaign of any size, nor any other sign in excess of twenty (20) square feet in area, shall be constructed, erected, moved, enlarged, illuminated, or substantially altered without first obtaining a sign permit from the Planning Director. No such permit shall be issued unless the application fee is paid and the proposed sign conforms with the requirements of this Code.

SECTION 3: Section 15-E. Prohibited Signs of the Development Code of the Village of Old Mill Creek is hereby amended to eliminate the following paragraph:

- Signs erected in connection with any election or political campaign.

SECTION 4: Section 15-F. Permitted Signs of the Development Code of the Village of Old Mill Creek is amended to add the following paragraph:

- Signs erected in connection with any election, referendum or political campaign not greater than four (4) square feet. There will be no permit fee for such sign. All said signs shall be removed within two (2) days of the relevant election or balloting.
