### Political Sign Ordinance

#### [Sec. 70-117. - Political signs.](#)

- (a) Political signs will not be displayed on public property.
- (b) Public property is defined as parkways, roadways, parks, poles on public property, school property and any property owned by a public entity.
- (c) Political signs shall not exceed six square feet in area nor be more than six feet in height per sign. Such signs are not subject to the sign ordinance, except as provided in this section.
- (d) Reserved.
- (e) Signs violating this section will be removed by the city at a cost of \$5.00 per sign, charged to the candidate through their local agent or representative.
- (f) The city clerk shall give each candidate promoting or advertising their candidacy within the City of Zion for any public office, a copy of this provision in person or by certified mail.
