Notice is hereby given that Statements of Interest (SOI) are requested (together with statements of qualifications and performance data from those firms which do not have such a statement on file with this agency) for furnishing professional civil engineering services on the following projects.

SOI shall be submitted via email to [DOT@lakecountyil.gov](mailto:DOT@lakecountyil.gov) and be addressed to the County Engineer, Lake County Division of Transportation, 600 West Winchester Road, Libertyville, Illinois, 60048.

Respondents shall include in their SOI a **prioritized listing** of the projects which are best suited to the capabilities and qualifications of their firm accompanied by a brief description of why the particular projects were chosen. A current IDOT prequalification listing shall also be included with the submittal. Statements of qualifications and performance data should be concise and directly relate to the projects of interest.

Submission deadline is **10:00 A.M. on Friday, March 30, 2012.**

**1) Section #99-00260-01-WR, Phase I Engineering Services**

- **14th Street, IL Route 131 to Jackson Street – 5 lane reconstruction**
- Project will reconstruct 4-lane pavement and add a center lane within the 1.1 mile project limits. Preliminary engineering (Phase I) will include determination of future capacity and an evaluation of the existing pavement structure will be required to determine reconstruction strategy. Intersections within the project limits will be studied. Project also includes studying and addressing the pedestrian and bicycle needs in the project area. The work will include field surveys, a wetlands delineation and report, a soils report, coordination with utility companies, determination of proposed right-of-way and preparation of plats and legal descriptions, analysis of the existing drainage, an intersection design study, and other Phase I work. Engineering costs will be locally funded; however, the federal Phase I process will be followed to ensure eligibility for federal construction funding.

**2) Section #12-00999-31-WR, Phase I Engineering Services**

- **IL Route 120, Knight Avenue to IL Route 131 – Widening from 4 to 5 lanes**

- This project involves adding a center turn lane within the 0.43 mile project length. Phase I engineering will include determination of future capacity and right-of-way needs, and the determination of sidewalk and/or bike path needs in the project corridor. An evaluation of the existing pavement condition will be required to determine if reconstruction is recommended. Intersections within the project limits will be studied. The work will include field surveys, a wetlands delineation and report, a soils report, coordination with utility companies, determination of proposed right-of-way and preparation of plats and legal descriptions, analysis of the existing drainage and floodplain, and other Phase I work. Engineering and construction costs for this project will be locally funded.

### **3) Section #09-00088-18-WR, Phase I Engineering Services**

- **Aptakisic Road, IL Route 83 to Buffalo Grove Road – Widening to 5-lane section**
- This capacity project involves adding an additional through lane in each direction within the 1.25 mile project length. Phase I engineering will include determination of future capacity and right-of-way needs, and determination of sidewalk and/or bike path needs in the project corridor. An evaluation of the existing pavement condition will be required to determine if reconstruction is recommended. Intersections within the project limits will be studied. The work will include field surveys, a wetlands delineation and report, a soils report, coordination with utility companies, analysis of the existing drainage and floodplain, and other work. Engineering costs will be locally funded; however the federal Phase I process will be followed to ensure eligibility for federal construction funding.
