Notice is hereby given that Statements of Interest (SOI) are requested together with Statements of Qualifications (SOQ) for furnishing professional civil engineering services on the following projects. 1. **Section 13-00055-06-WR**, preparation of a Phase I study, in accordance with the Illinois Department of Transportation's Bureau of Local Roads & Streets Policies & Procedures for Federal-Aid Projects, for an intersection improvement project at Wadsworth Road and Lewis Avenue in Beach Park and Waukegan, Illinois. The proposed intersection improvement will add turn lanes and a traffic signal. Phase I work will include an intersection design study; field surveys; preliminary plans with proposed horizontal and vertical alignments; hydraulic analysis; identification of detention requirements; coordination meetings with utility companies; coordinating, attending, and providing appropriate presentation materials for public meetings; coordination with LCSMC, permitting agencies and local communities; a wetlands delineation and report; a soils report; a determination of proposed right-of-way and/or easements and the preparation of plats and legal descriptions; and an environment assessment (PESA and PSI).
2. **Section 13-00999-47-ES**, preparation of a Phase I study, in accordance with the Illinois Department of Transportation's Bureau of Local Roads & Streets Policies & Procedures for Federal-Aid Projects, for intersection improvements at Wadsworth Road and Dilleys Road, Wadsworth Road and US 41, as well as Wadsworth Road and Kilbourne Road near the Village of Wadsworth, Illinois. The proposed project will improve the safety and operation of these intersections. The study should consider roadway realignment, intersection signalization, roundabouts, or other methods to satisfy the project objectives. Phase I work will include field surveys; preliminary plans with proposed horizontal and vertical alignments; intersection design studies; hydraulic analysis; identification of detention requirements; coordination meetings with utility companies; coordinating, attending, and providing appropriate presentation materials for public meetings; coordination with LCSMC, permitting agencies and local communities; a wetlands delineation and report; a soils report; a determination of proposed right-of-way and/or easements and the preparation of plats and legal descriptions; and an environmental assessment (PESA and PSI).
3. **Section 13-00107-09-ES**, preparation of a Phase I study, in accordance with the Illinois Department of Transportation's Bureau of Local Roads & Streets Policies & Procedures for Federal-Aid Projects, for intersection improvements at Darrell Road and Fisher Road, Darrell Road at Dowell Road, Darrell Road at Neville Road and Darrell Road at Case Road near Island Lake, Illinois. The proposed project will improve the safety and operation of these intersections. The study should consider roadway realignment, intersection signalization, roundabouts, or other methods to satisfy the project objectives. Phase I work will include field surveys; preliminary plans with proposed horizontal and vertical

alignments; intersection design studies; hydraulic analysis; identification of detention requirements; an area network safety analysis; coordination meetings with utility companies; coordinating, attending, and providing appropriate presentation materials for public meetings; coordination with LCSMC, permitting agencies and local communities; a wetlands delineation and report; a soils report; a determination of proposed right-of-way and/or easements and the preparation of plats and legal descriptions; and an environmental assessment (PESA and PSI).

Respondents shall include in their SOI a prioritized listing of the above design projects (1, 2, 3) which are best suited to the capabilities and qualifications of their firm. The SOI shall be accompanied by a brief description of why the particular project(s) were chosen. A current IDOT prequalification listing shall also be included with the submittal. Statement of Qualifications should be concise and directly relate to the project(s) of interest.

The County, in accordance with the laws of the State of Illinois, hereby notifies all firms expressing statements of interest that it will affirmatively insure that the contract entered into pursuant to this advertisement will be awarded without discrimination on the grounds of race, color or national origin.
