

ORDINANCE NO. 10-O-018
AN ORDINANCE AMENDING
TITLE 5 OF CHAPTER 20,
SECTION 20, SUBSECTION D.1.
OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE
PERTAINING TO POLITICAL SIGNS

WHEREAS, after careful study, and in order to be in compliance with state law, the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Kildeer have determined that it is useful, appropriate, and in the best interests of the Village to amend Title 5, Chapter 20, Section 20, Subsection D.1. of the Village of Kildeer Municipal Code, pertaining to political signs, in the manner provided in this Ordinance;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Kildeer, Lake County and State of Illinois, as follows:

SECTION ONE: Recitals. The foregoing recitals are incorporated herein as findings of the President and Board of Trustees of the Village of Kildeer.

SECTION TWO: Amendment. Village Code 5-20-20 subsection D. shall be hereby amended to read as follows:

1. Political Signs: All political signs must be displayed only on private property. No permit is required for political signs.

SECTION THREE: Effective Date. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect as of November 2, 2010 and after its passage, approval, and publication in pamphlet form as provided by law.
