Public Question Regarding Program For Aggregation Of Electricity

Shall the Village of Old Mill Creek have the authority to arrange for the supply of electricity for its residential and small commercial retail customers who have not opted out of such program?

VILLAGE OF ROUND LAKE PARK

Proposition To Increase The Property Tax Extension Limitation

Shall the extension limitation under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for the Village of Round Lake Park, Lake County, Illinois, be increased from the lesser of 5% or the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index over the prior levy year to 37.153% per year for 2013?

For the 2013 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$90.58.

MILLBURN C.C. SCHOOL DISTRICT #24

Proposition To Increase The Extension Limitation

Shall the extension limitation under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for Millburn Community Consolidated School District Number 24, Lake County, Illinois, be increased from the lesser of 5% or the percentage increase in the Consumer Price Index over the prior levy year to 12% for the 2013 levy year?

For the 2013 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$114.00.

MCHENRY COMM HIGH SCHOOL DIST #156

Proposition To Issue \$2,200,000 School Building Bonds

Shall the Board of Education of McHenry Community High School District Number 156, McHenry and Lake Counties, Illinois, alter, repair, equip and provide technology and other improvements to the buildings and facilities of the school district and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$2,200,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?

TOWNSHIP HIGH SCHOOL DISTRICT #113

Proposition To Issue \$89,000,000 School Building Bonds

Shall the Board of Education of Township High School District Number 113, Lake County, Illinois, for its Highland Park and Deerfield High Schools, improve the safety and efficiency of physical plants, build and equip additions and renovations to such schools for instructional purposes, repair and replace infrastructure, remove, renovate and repair portions of such schools, improve the sites for such schools and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$89,000,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?
