#### STATE OF ILLINOIS

Proposed Amendment To The 1970 Illinois Constitution

Explanation of Amendment

The proposed amendment, which takes effect upon approval by the voters, adds a new section to the Suffrage and Elections Article of the Illinois Constitution. The new section would provide the State's electors with an option to petition for a special election to recall a Governor and for the special election of a successor Governor. At the general election to be held on November 2, 2010, you will be called upon to decide whether the proposed amendment should become part of the Illinois Constitution.

If you believe the Illinois Constitution should be amended to provide for a special election to recall a Governor and for a special election to elect a successor Governor, you should vote "**YES**" on the question. If you believe the Illinois Constitution should not be amended to provide for a special election to recall a Governor and for a special election to elect a successor Governor, you should vote "**NO**" on the question. Three-fifths of those voting on the question or a majority of those voting in the election must vote "YES" in order for the amendment to become effective.

Shall bonds in the amount of \$11,775,000 be issued for Library purposes by the Village of Deerfield, for remodeling and expanding the library building by 10,000 sq. ft. including site preparation, and the remodeling, improving, and rehabilitating of the existing building, including technology, related fixtures, materials, furnishings and improvements?

## **VILLAGE OF DEER PARK**

Proposition To Approve A Non-Home Rule Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax And Non-Home Rule Municipal Service Occupation Tax

Shall the Village of Deer Park be authorized to impose a Municipal Retailers' Occupation Tax and a Municipal Service Occupation Tax within the Village in accordance with 65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.1, 5/8-11-1.2, 5/8-11-1.3, and 5/8-11-1.4, at a rate of 1/4 of 1% for expenditure on public infrastructure, such as Village roads and streets and storm water drainage improvements?

65 ILCS 5/8-11-1.2 defines "public infrastructure" as: municipal roads and streets, access roads, bridges, and sidewalks; waste disposal systems; and water and sewer line extensions, water distribution and purification facilities, storm water drainage and retention facilities, and sewage treatment facilities.

## **VILLAGE OF WHEELING**

Proposition To Increase The Monthly 911 Emergency Telephone System Surcharge

Shall the Village of Wheeling impose an increase of seventy cents (\$0.70) per month to raise the current monthly surcharge from seventy-five cents (\$0.75) per month to one-dollar and forty-five cents (\$1.45) per month per network connection, which surcharge will be added to the monthly bill you receive for telephone or telecommunications charges, for the purpose of improving and maintaining the 9-1-1 Emergency Telephone System?

## **LAKE BLUFF PARK DISTRICT**

Proposition To Issue \$10.7 Million Park Bonds

Shall the Lake Bluff Park District, Lake County, Illinois, construct and equip an outdoor community pool and related facilities, maintain, improve and preserve its parks and facilities, pay expenses incident thereto and issue its bonds to the amount of \$10.7 million for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?

## **CARY C.C. SCHOOL DISTRICT #26**

Proposition To Issue \$15,000,000 Working Cash Fund Bonds

Shall the Board of Education of Cary Community Consolidated School District Number 26, McHenry and Lake Counties, Illinois, be authorized to issue \$15,000,000 bonds for a working cash fund as provided for by Article 20 of the School Code?

## **GURNEE SCHOOL DISTRICT #56**

Proposition To Issue \$28,500,000 School Building Bonds

Shall the Board of Education of Gurnee School District Number 56, Lake County, Illinois, build and equip a school building and administrative facilities, improve the site or sites thereof, build and equip an addition to and alter, repair and equip the O'Plaine School Building, demolish the Gurnee Grade School Building and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$28,500,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?

## **MILLBURN C.C. SCHOOL DISTRICT #24**

### Proposition To Increase The Limiting Rate

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for Millburn Community Consolidated School District No. 24, Lake County, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to .729% above the limiting rate for the purpose for which the School District is organized for levy year 2009 and be equal to 3.580% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy year 2010?

- (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$8,423,574, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$10,577,480.
- (2) For the 2010 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$244.
- (3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for the 2010 levy year will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).

## **MCHENRY COMM HIGH SCHOOL DIST #156**

### Proposition To Issue \$70,000,000 School Building Bonds

Shall the Board of Education of McHenry Community High School District Number 156, McHenry and Lake Counties, Illinois, build and equip a new high school building to replace the McHenry East Campus facilities, improve the site thereof and issue bonds of said School District to the amount of \$70,000,000 for the purpose of paying the costs thereof?

## **MCHENRY COMM HIGH SCHOOL DIST #156**

### Proposition To Increase The Limiting Rate

Shall the limiting rate under the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law for McHenry Community High School District Number 156, McHenry and Lake Counties, Illinois, be increased by an additional amount equal to 0.6000% above the limiting rate for levy year 2009 for school purposes and be equal to 1.9905% of the equalized assessed value of the taxable property therein for levy year 2010?

- (1) The approximate amount of taxes extendable at the most recently extended limiting rate is \$20,161,368, and the approximate amount of taxes extendable if the proposition is approved is \$28,860,988.
- (2) For the 2010 levy year the approximate amount of the additional tax extendable against property containing a single family residence and having a fair market value at the time of the referendum of \$100,000 is estimated to be \$200.00.
- (3) If the proposition is approved, the aggregate extension for 2010 will be determined by the limiting rate set forth in the proposition, rather than the otherwise applicable limiting rate calculated under the provisions of the Property Tax Extension Limitation Law (commonly known as the Property Tax Cap Law).
