I understand that to meet the legal requirements and qualify to apply to the Student Election Judge Program, I must:

- Be enrolled as a Junior or Senior in a public or private secondary school, with a cumulative 3.0 GPA or higher,
- Be a U.S. citizen at the time of the next election,
- Have written approval from a parent or guardian and school principal,
- Satisfactorily complete an election judge training course
- Register to vote if 18 years of age on or before the next General/Consolidated Election.
- Assist other judges and share responsibility for the operation of the voting site,
- Provide a copy of assignment letter to the appropriate school personnel to receive an excused absence for the day and collect and complete any assignments that are missed.

Time Commitment and Compensation:

- 5:15 AM - 8:15 PM or later. All Election Judges must assist with voting site closing/tear-down procedures.
- Compensation: \$140.00 - Must work on Election Day for the total duration to receive full compensation.
